

DEFAULT REPAYMENT VERIFICATION

To receive financial aid, a student cannot be in default on any U.S. Department of Education student loan or owe a refund on a federal grant. According to the Department of Education, their records indicate that you are in default or owe a refund on a federal grant. Until your default or over payment is resolved, you will not be eligible for federal aid. Please submit one of the documents listed below to the Financial Aid Office, or call the number if one is listed.

Acceptable Documents:

- A copy of the Paid-In Full notice you received when your student loan(s) was paid.
- A copy of the notice you received when your loan(s) was consolidated.
- A Satisfactory Payment letter from the lender or other agency showing you have made at least six (6) current consecutive payments on your student loan(s).
