

FACT SHEET FOR ELIGIBLE NONCITIZENS

In order to apply for federal financial aid you must verify your eligible non-citizen status. To continue processing your file, you must submit one of the following forms (acceptable documentation) to our office.

- **Non-citizen National**

U.S Passport	Must be stamped "Non-citizen National".
U.S Passport Card	Issued after July 1, 2008

- **Permanent Resident**

"Alien Registration Receipt Card" Form I-151, I-551, or I-551C	The I-551C must have a currently valid expiration date.
Passport	Must be stamped "Processed for I-551" with expiration date.
I-94	Must be stamped "Processed for I-551" with expiration date, or "Temporary Form I-551", with appropriate information filled in.

- **Other Eligible Citizen**

"Arrival-Departure Record" Form I-94	Must be stamped as a Refugee, Asylum Status Conditional Entrant (before April 1, 1980), Parolee Cuban-Haitian Entrant.
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Note: INS requires a copy of both the front and back of the requested document. Please make sure the document is legible.

The Financial Aid Office will place your file in a holding status until an acceptable document is received
