Correctional Education Professional Development Courses

These dynamic courses are designed for employees of California Correctional and Rehabilitation Institutions in order to meet professional development demands for salary advancement. Courses are currently offered online. Students will receive 4.5 CEUs and a certification of completion from National University for each course.

Diversity in a Correctional Environment

An examination of incarcerated life and of the prison experience. Seeking to answer the question "what is it really like to be a prison inmate?" this course delves into diverse overviews of many of the most critical aspects of correctional culture and life. Special attention is devoted to ensuring a diversity of views and a diversity of experiences in the issues and readings presented. Also includes broad coverage of psychological adaptations of inmates, relationships inside prison, substance use/abuse, violence, healthcare, and media portrayals of the prison experience. Facilitating Incarcerated Adult Learners

An overview of the most current thinking on adult learning. Facilitating Incarcerated Adult Learners addresses a wide range of topics including: Who are adult learners? How do adults learn? Why are adults involved in learning activities? How does the social context shape the learning that adults are engaged in? How does aging affect learning ability? How does drug abuse affect learning ability? All of these topics are examined and applied to incarcerated adult learners in a correctional education setting. Also includes coverage of relationships inside prison, substance use/abuse, violence, healthcare and media portrayals of the prison experience.

Behavior Management in a Correctional Classroom

This course examines the behavioral, psychodynamic, biophysical, and environmental theories of behavior management. Emphasis is placed on practical eclectic approaches and strategies useful for managing student behavior in correctional education settings, while maintaining professionalism, safety, and security.
