Associate of Science/Certificate in Health Information Technology

Qualified construction managers are currently in high demand and are expected to remain so for years to come. Learn the skills necessary for estimating, scheduling, bidding, and executing the construction plans developed by architects and engineers. Earn your degree and

Upon completion of the Nondestructive Testing Certification Program students will have acquired the skills necessary in determining the integrity of structures in accordance with various industry codes and standards.

you'll be qualified for a variety of project management positions at design-build, construction management, general contractor, and subcontracting firms.

The Associate of Science degree in Construction Management consists of 90 quarter credits, and includes 60 quarter credits in core courses and 30 quarter credits in general education courses. This degree is offered online, meaning you can take classes on your own schedule and complete each course in just five weeks.

Nondestructive Testing Certification

Earn your Nondestructive Testing (NDT) Certification at NPCS and you will have the knowledge and skills necessary to determine the condition and integrity of a wide range of components and structures in accordance with various industry codes and standards. The NDT program includes training in the use of sophisticated techniques such as ultrasonic magnetic particle, dye penetrant, and visual inspection. Completion will prepare you for job opportunities in industries including underwater inspection, construction, manufacturing, aerospace, energy, and transportation. Students will also receive the following letters of qualification:

- Ultrasonic Testing (UT) to Level II (longitudinal and shearwave)
- Magnetic Particle Testing (MT) to Level II
- Dye Penetrant Testing (PT) to Level II
- Visual Weld Inspection (VT) to Level II

The letter of qualification demonstrates that the graduate has been trained to the American Society of Nondestructive Testing (ANST) standards and the ISO 9000 series.



MARINE TECHNOLOGY DIVISION

Turn your experience and love of adventure and action into a profitable career with an Associate of Science degree or a certificate in Marine Technology. Through a balance of lectures and hands-on courses, you'll develop the skills and experience needed to pursue a career in commercial diving, with concentrations in advanced dive medicine, nondestructive testing, and underwater welding.

Associate of Science in Marine Technology

The Associate of Science degree in Marine Technology increases your opportunities for advancement in the marine technology field. Earn your degree

through successful completion of general education credits and the Marine Technology Certificates.

Marine Technology Certificates

NPCS' Marine Technology Certificates provide you with the skills and training for entry into the diverse field of commercial diving.

Marine Technology I provides you with the basic skills for surface supplied air diving and prepares you for further study. The student learns safe diving procedures, professional work habits, and technical diving skills.

Marine Technology II improves your skills with 20 weeks of study in one of four concentrations that offer advance training for the major employment areas of commercial diving.

The Certificate and Associate of Science degree programs in Marine Technology require the successful completion of one of the following concentrations:

Advanced Dive Medicine (MedTech)

The MedTech concentration prepares students in the medical aspects of diving and advanced training in hyperbaric medicine. Graduates gain certification as an Advanced Diving

Employment of emergency medical technicians is expected to grow faster than the average for all occupations through 2010.

Medical Technician, qualified for work as a “tender” or diver medic on inland and offshore job sites. This concentration also qualifies you to take the Emergency Medical Technician-Basic (EMT-B) exam.

Homeland Security Management

Available for military divers who have already completed diver training, the Homeland Security Management concentration provides the knowledge, procedures, and techniques needed by students who have already completed diver training for a career in homeland security.

Underwater Inspection Technology (SpecTech)

The SpecTech concentration prepares you to conduct a number of advanced underwater inspection and testing techniques important for insuring the quality of underwater construction.

You'll be trained to American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ANST) Level I and Level II standards in Ultrasonic Testing (UT), Magnetic Particle Testing (MT), Dye Penetrant Testing (PT) and Visual Testing (VT).

Underwater Welding Technology (WeldTech)

The WeldTech concentration gives you the in-depth training and extensive practice required to master the specialized skill of underwater welding and enhance your job prospects. The following welder performance qualifications are available:

- American Welding Society (AWS)
D 1.1: 2G, 1” Plate Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW)¹
- AWS D 1.1: 3G and 4G, 1” Plate, SMAW
- AWS D 1.1: 3G and 4G, 1” Plate, Flux-Core Arc Welding (FCAW)
- AWS D 3.6: 3F, 4F, and 5F; Class B Wet SMAW²

¹ Candidates must have this welding qualification prior to beginning the WeldTech concentration.

² This program utilizes two different certified wet welding procedure specifications (AWS D 3.6 and Class B Pipe-Fillet) to govern the underwater welding training. We are the only accredited commercial diving training facility in the world to employ such industry-standard certified programs.



SECURITY MANAGEMENT DIVISION
