This certificate prepares you to become a Dropout Prevention Specialist and serve as an advocate in the lives of children in at-risk situations.

Autism Education Certificate ○

National Board Certification Teacher (NBCT) Academy and Monthly Collaborative Sessions with Online Supplements

Three options are available to help teachers seeking National Board certification.

Vocational Education

This two-part series helps students earn their Designated Subject Credential in vocational and technical education.

CSET Preparation Course

Created and taught by credentialed subject-matter experts, these courses give a comprehensive overview of all subject matter needed to pass the California Subject Examinations for Teachers (CSET). The courses have been designed to match the structure and rigor of academic courses and are taught one month prior to the offering of a CSET test.

Preparation courses are available for the CSET tests covering English, science, social science, math, and multiple subjects.

Test Preparation Courses

Get help preparing for the U.S. Constitution and RICA tests.

Self Paced CD-ROMs

A variety of self-paced courses are available to satisfy teacher CEU requirements for career advancement. Subjects covered include Attention Deficit Disorder, classroom management, diversity, learning disabilities, inclusion, and reading, among others.

Behavior Management Workshop

Certificate Programs

Enterprise Excellence Certificate Programs

Extended Learning offers Lean Six Sigma certifications in Green Belt, Black Belt, and Master Black Belt levels for professionals seeking to develop high-level skills in organization, project management, and leadership.

These programs train professionals in the implementation of Lean Six Sigma for achieving Enterprise Excellence. Enterprise Excellence is a holistic approach used to help organizations be more agile, and capable of quickly addressing problems, changing missions, changing requirements, changing technology, changing markets, and new opportunities.

National University's Division of Extended Learning's programs allow individuals with little or no knowledge of Lean Six Sigma to gain understanding through practical hands-on courses that will prepare them to implement Lean Six Sigma concepts in their own projects.

In conjunction with the Management Science Division of VSE Corporation, Extended Learning offers training that can be tailored to the needs of any organization. Training completion earns the issuance of either CEUs or graduate academic credit. Coursework completed in the Green Belt and Black Belt levels of training will result in graduate credit that can be applied towards a Master of Science degree in Engineering


Management or a Master of Science degree in Systems Engineering, offered through National University's School of Engineering and Technology.

Lean Six Sigma Green Belt Certification

The Lean Six Sigma Green Belt program includes courses in the fundamentals of process analysis and optimization, operational efficiency and cost effectiveness, and a Lean Six Sigma practicum project. Several training schedule options are available and each can be tailored to best suit your scheduling requirements.

Lean Six Sigma Black Belt Certification

The Black Belt program covers fundamentals of leading and managing continuous measurable improvement, advanced topics in process analysis, and a Lean Six Sigma practicum project. Several training schedule options are available and each can be tailored to best suit your scheduling requirements.



Take your management skills to another level with a Lean Six Sigma Green Belt, Black Belt, or Master Black Belt Certification.

Combined Lean Six Sigma Green Belt and Black Belt Certification

This intensive option allows students to earn both Green and Black Belt certifications quickly. Two weeks (80 hours) of Green Belt and two weeks (80 hours) of Black Belt training are taken consecutively, followed by two weeks of onsite consulting and completion of the Black Belt Project. This option is designed for high-performing teams.

Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belt Certification

This course prepares Lean Six Sigma Black Belts to become Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belts, capable of serving as members of leadership teams working to achieve Enterprise Excellence.

Enterprise Architecture Certificate Programs

This program is a convenient way to get federally required Enterprise Architecture certifications in Federal Enterprise Architecture Framework and/or Department of Defense Architecture Framework. Offered in

conjunction with the Federal Enterprise Architecture Certification (FEAC) Institute, students can earn either CEUs or graduate academic credit.

Department of Defense Architecture Framework (DoDAF) Certification

This program includes architecture framework basics, core and supporting products, architecture analysis, architecture modeling, and an enterprise architecture practicum and thesis.

Federal Enterprise Architecture (Framework) [FEA(F)] Certification Program

In this program, you'll study architecture concepts, implementation, and integration, and take part in an enterprise architecture practicum and thesis.

Cisco CCNA Exploration

This program provides a comprehensive overview of networking from fundamentals to advanced applications and services. Theoretical
