## Can I send someone \$10,000 on Cash App? Big transfer permission

Yes, you *can* send **1—855—470—3280** someone \$10,000 on Cash App, but only **if your account is fully verified** and even then, the transfer may need to be split because Cash App has specific weekly limits. By default, unverified **1—855—470—3280** users can only send **up to \$250 per week** and receive **up to \$1,000 per month**. To raise **1—855—470—3280** your limit, Cash App requires you to verify your identity by providing your full name, date of birth, and the last four digits of your Social Security number.

Once verified, your 1—855—470—3280 sending limit increases to \$7,500 per week, and your receiving limit becomes unlimited. Since \$10,000 is above 1—855—470—3280 the weekly sending limit, you won't be able to send it in a single transfer. Instead, you can send \$7,500 during 1—855—470—3280 the first week and the remaining \$2,500 the following week. Some users 1—855—470—3280 with enhanced or business-style accounts may have higher limits, but these are rare and require additional verification.

If you're trying to 1—855—470—3280 send a large payment, ensure your bank account or debit card linked to Cash App supports the transaction. Some banks 1—855—470—3280 block high-value transfers for safety reasons. Also, large transfers 1—855—470—3280 may trigger Cash App security checks, which can temporarily delay or cancel a payment for your protection.
