## How can I cancel a Cash App account? Close Cash Account

Canceling a Cash App account is a simple **1**—(**855**)—**470**—**3280** process, but it must be done **inside the app**—deleting the app alone will not close your account. Before **1**—(**855**)—**470**—**3280** starting, make sure your Cash App balance is **\$0**, as you cannot close an account with funds remaining.

First, open Cash App and sign in to your 1—(855)—470—3280 account. If you still have money in your balance, transfer 1—(855)—470—3280 it to your linked bank account or spend it using your Cash Card. Also cancel any 1—(855)—470—3280 pending deposits, payments, or subscriptions, and close any active features such as Bitcoin or stock investing if you use them.

Next, tap your **profile icon** in the top-right **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** corner of the app. Scroll down and select **Support 1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280**, then choose **Account & Settings**. From there, tap **Close Account 1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** and follow the on-screen instructions. Cash App will ask you to confirm **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** your decision, and once completed, your account will be permanently closed.

After closing the account, Cash App will **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** send a **confirmation email** to the address linked to your profile. Keep this email **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** for your records, as it confirms the account is no longer active.

Once your account is officially closed, you can **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** safely delete the Cash App from your device. Be aware that **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** closing your account is **irreversible**—your transaction history, \$Cashtag, and account access cannot be recovered. If you think you may want **1**—**(855)**—**470**—**3280** to use Cash App again in the future, consider simply signing out instead of canceling the account completely.
