International Prospective Student Scholarship

The International Student Scholarship is available to prospective International Students at National University. Each applicant must meet the minimum eligibility qualification for consideration. The students selected for this scholarship will be awarded tuition reimbursement for 50 percent of the first four courses in their academic program.

Eligibility | Qualifications:

In order to be considered for this scholarship, students must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be accepted into a National University academic program
- Be on an F1 student visa at the time of program commencement
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for undergraduate applicants; 2.5 for graduate applicants from previous degree completed. *(to be internally confirmed by NU registrar's office)*
- Submit a Statement of Purpose describing the applicant's academic goals, previous experience in community service, extracurricular activities, and if applicable work experience
- Satisfy the University English requirement as stated in the catalog
- Submit two letters of professional or academic recommendation dated no later than nine months from current date

International Student Leadership Scholarship

The International Student Leadership Scholarship is available to International students currently enrolled at National University. Each applicant must demonstrate extraordinary leadership in either academics or community service for consideration. The students selected for this scholarship will be awarded tuition reimbursement for 50 percent of two courses of their current academic program.

Eligibility | Qualifications:

In order to be considered for this scholarship students must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be a current National University academic student for at least one quarter
- Be in good academic standing
- Be on an F1 student visa
- Submit an academic recommendation letter by a National University faculty member
- Submit a professional or academic recommendation letter dated no later than nine months from current date
- Submit a Statement of Purpose describing how they have demonstrated outstanding leadership in either NU academics or the community, along with their academic goals, previous experience in community service, extracurricular activities, and if applicable work experience.
