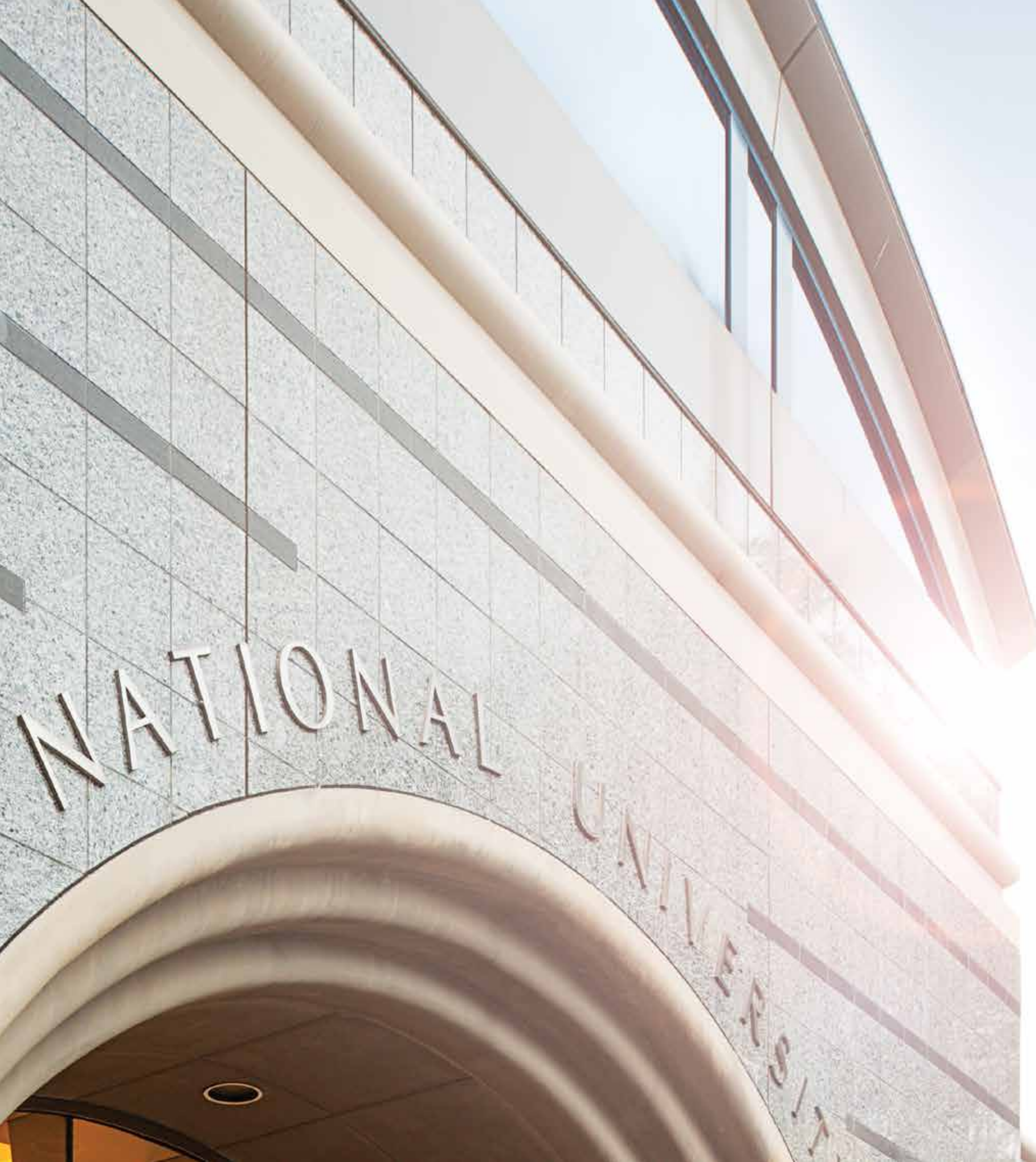

- Accredited by the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education (IACBE) for programs offered by the School of Business & Management

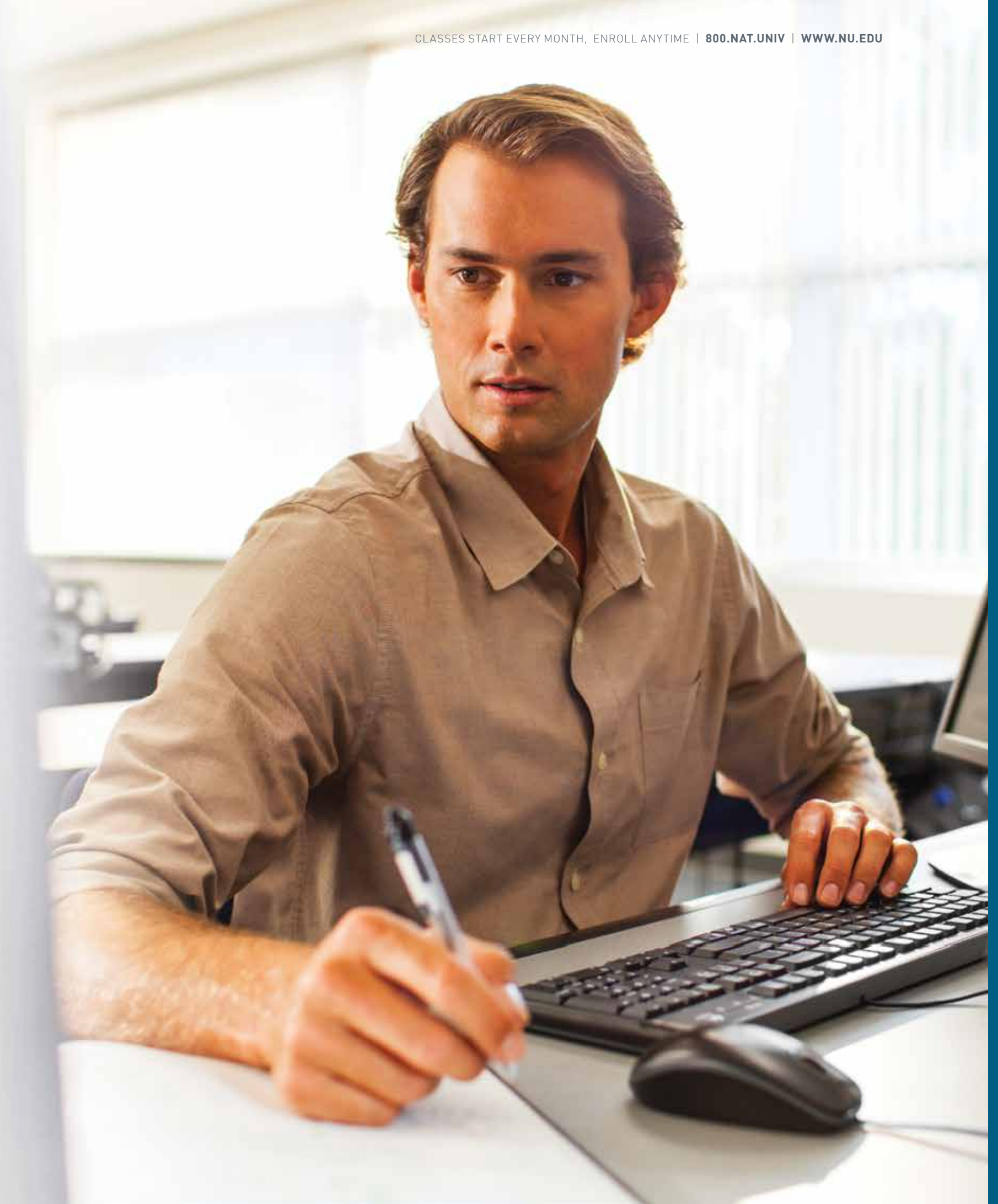
RANKINGS

ACCELERATED, ONE-COURSE-PER-MONTH FORMAT

YEAR-ROUND REGISTRATION

- Merit-based scholarships for those who demonstrate exceptional academic achievement
- Military tuition scholarships for eligible military personnel, spouses, and dependents
- Special scholarships for students who are enrolling directly from the California Community College System:
 - Transfer to Triumph Scholarship - waives \$60 application fee and pays for the last two courses of your undergraduate degree
 - Promising Scholar Scholarship - pays for 50 percent of the first two courses taken at National University
 - Presidential Tuition Scholarship - up to \$250 to undergraduate transfer students who meet certain criteria
