Re: CCNE Calls for Third-Party Comments

The Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE)—a nationally recognized accrediting agency for baccalaureate and graduate nursing programs is conducting a tenyear reaccreditation virtual visit for National University's Department of Nursing from November 2-4, 2020.

In accordance with CCNE's procedures, the Commission provides the opportunity for program constituents and other interested parties to submit, in writing, third-party comments concerning a program's qualifications for accreditation. Third-party comments regarding programs hosting Fall 2020 evaluations must be received by CCNE no later than 21 days prior to the first day of the on-site evaluation (11/2/2020).

Third party comments must relate to the CCNE Standards for Accreditation of Baccalaureate and Graduate Nursing Programs (2018). All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English, consistent with CCNE's policy on Conduct of Business in English. Comments are shared only with the CCNE evaluation team appointed to review the noted nursing programs.
