Indicators Used

INDICATOR	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED
Retention Rate	One-year retention rates were calculated by following a group of entering students in a given fiscal year (FY) and seeing who was still active the next FY. We cannot calculate the retention rates for FY19 until FY20 has past. Percentages based on small numbers of students may explain the variation over time.
Graduation Rate	Graduation rates are calculated by taking the number of students who graduated divided by the total number of students who started in that cohort. 150% time to completion is 6 years for bachelor seeking students and 3 years for associate and masters degree seeking students. The most recent graduation rate that we can provide is FY13 for bachelor students and FY16 for master and associate students.
