



Will Short Term Disability insurance benefits be paid for absences related to COVID-19?

If you are located in California, you are eligible for benefits under the State Disability Insurance Plan (SDI). SDI will pay up to 60% of your weekly earnings to a weekly maximum.

SDI will pay benefits for:

- The quarantine period for yourself. It will not cover time off to care for a family member who must be quarantined.

If you're unable to work because you are caring for an ill or quarantined family member with COVID-19 (certified by a medical professional), you can file a Paid Family Leave (PFL) claim.

- Should you be diagnosed with COVID-19, SDI will pay for the period of time you are unable to work.
- PFL provides up to six weeks of benefit payments to eligible workers who have a full or partial loss of wages because they need time off work to care for a seriously ill family member or to bond with a new child. PFL will pay up to 60% of your weekly earnings to a weekly maximum
