TIMELYMD CONTEST

(a) OFFICIAL RULES

Participation in the **TIMELYMD CONTEST** (the "Contest") constitutes your agreement to be bound by these Official Rules ("Official Rules").

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR TO WIN THE CONTEST. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR LIKELIHOOD OF WINNING.

ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

- Sponsor & Administrator: TimelyMD is the administrator of the Contest (the "Administrator"). The

 ("Sponsor"). Sponsor's address is 9388 Lightwave Ave., San Diego, CA 9213. Sponsor and Administrator
 may sometimes be collectively referred to herein as the "Contest Entities."
- 2. Eligibility: The Contest is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry. All entrants under the age of eighteen (18) must have consent from their parents or guardians to enter the Contest and be bound by these Official Rules. Participation in this Contest constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and to the Contest Entities' decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest. The Contest Entities reserve the right to verify the eligibility of any person during and after the Contest Period.
- **3.** <u>Contest Period</u>: The Contest begins at 12AM Pacific Time on August 1, 2022, and ends at 11:59PM Pacific Time on September 20, 2022 (the "Contest Period").
- **4.** How to Enter: To qualify for entry, you must have a valid NU student email account. To enter the Contest, you must complete *all* of the following actions during the Contest Period: (1) register for a TimelyCare account.
 - By submitting your Entry, you agree that it conforms to the guidelines, permissions, and content restrictions below and that NU, in its sole discretion may disqualify you if it believes that it fails to conform. Important: If you are participating in this Contest via a mobile device, message and data rates may apply. You should consult your wireless service provider regarding its pricing plans. Participation may not be available on all mobile devices, as not all mobile devices or cellular telephone providers have the capabilities or carry the service necessary to participate in this method of entry.
- 5. Entry Guidelines and Permissions: You must be the National University student registering for the TimelyCare account. Contest Entities reserve the right to change these Terms and Conditions from time to time, as necessary. Although Contest Entities may attempt to notify entrants when major changes are made to these Terms and Conditions, applicants should periodically review the most up-to-date version found at [web address]. Contest entities may, in their sole discretion, modify or revise these Terms and Conditions at any time, and entrants registration will signify assent and acceptance to the Terms and Conditions, including any such modifications or revisions. - 6. <u>Limitations on Entry</u>: Limit one (1) entry per person during the Contest Period. Any Entry received from any person in excess of the stated limit will be void. An Entry generated by script, macro or other automated means are void. Multiple entrants are not permitted to share the same e-mail account. Any attempt by any entrant to obtain more than one (1) entry by using multiple/different e-mail accounts, identities, registrations and logins, or any other methods will void that entrant's entries and that entrant may be disqualified. In the event of a dispute as to any registration, the authorized account holder of the e-mail account used to register will be deemed to be the entrant. Winners agree to accept their prize "as is." The Contest Entities have the right to resolve any concerns, questions, or complaints related to the prizes in its sole discretion. General Conditions: The Contest Entities are not responsible for and are not liable for: (i) misdirected or delayed mail or e-mail; (ii) telephone, telecommunications, internet, hardware or third party software malfunctions, failures, or difficulties of any kind; (iii) any condition caused by events beyond the Sponsor's control that may cause the Contest to be disrupted, corrupted or terminated; (iv) any injuries, losses, or damages of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of participating in the Contest or use of the prize; or (iv) any printing or typographical errors in any materials associated with the Contest. The Contest Entities reserve the right to disqualify, in their sole discretion, any person tampering with the entry process, the operation of the systems required to conduct the Contest or operate the Contest Entities' web sites, or who is otherwise in violation of these Official Rules.
