To receive an MBA degree, students must complete 54 quarter units of graduate credit. A total of 13.5 quarter units of equivalent graduate work may be granted if completed with a grade of "B" or better (3.0 GPA) at another regionally accredited institution, as it applies to this degree and provided the units were not used in earning another advanced degree.

- Each course is four weeks long.
- The MBA program is 12-14 months long.
